- Identification: Shiny black with a distinctive red hourglass shape on the underside of their abdomen. Females are larger and more venomous than males.
- Behavior: Black widows are shy but can deliver painful and potentially dangerous bites. They are typically found in undisturbed areas like sheds, garages, and woodpiles.
- Treatment: We conduct thorough inspections to locate black widow nests and apply targeted insecticides to eliminate them. Preventative measures include removing clutter and sealing potential entry points.
