3. Pantry Beetles

- **Identification:** Various species, including sawtoothed grain beetles and flour beetles, are small, reddish-brown or black beetles.
- **Behavior:** Pantry beetles infest stored food products such as grains, cereals, flour, and dried fruits. They can contaminate food supplies, making them inedible.
- **Treatment:** We start by identifying and discarding infested food items, thoroughly cleaning storage areas, and applying insecticides to cracks and crevices where beetles may hide. Preventative measures include storing food in airtight containers.
