3. Cluster Flies

- **Identification:** Slightly larger than house flies, dark gray with golden hairs on their thorax, about 3/8 inch long.
- **Behavior:** Cluster flies enter homes in the fall to overwinter, often gathering in large numbers in attics and wall voids.
- **Treatment:** We use residual insecticides to treat areas where cluster flies gather. Preventative measures include sealing entry points and treating the exterior of your property to prevent flies from entering.
